## **Promoting eco-grazing**

Since 2019, Renault Trucks has been including sheep in the maintenance of its green spaces. At the Bourg-en-Bresse site, the upkeep of 14 hectares of green areas is being managed by some fifty sheep. Eco-grazing keeps the fauna, flora and ecosystems in good condition, while meeting the company's "zero phytosanitary products" target.

## **What is a good move?**

A Good Move is something that helps – or inspires us – at Renault Trucks to reach our ambitious goals of reducing CO<sub>2</sub> emissions.

## **Why is this a good move?**

This virtuous eco-grazing contributes to stimulating local biodiversity and reducing the spread of certain invasive plants, such as Japanese knotweed. This practice, which limits the use of lawnmowers, results in an annual reduction of 5 tonnes of organic waste.
